Frankie also has his Manx GP Newcomer weekend on 7th & 8th March so we obviously wish him all the best as he starts his journey towards the MGP in August.

Rhys is still in planning mode but we'd expect to see him at an early NG Racing event possibly at Pembrev.


Here's the calendar for the boys in the next couple of months and their first appearances if you want to go along and show them some support:
